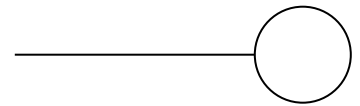


French Revolution: KEY TERMS



Term	Definition	Symbol, Sentence, or Question
First Estate	Clergy or Churchmen 1% of total French population	
Second Estate	Nobles or Wealthy Class 2% of French population	
Third Estate	Peasants, farmers, doctors, lawyers, merchants, and servants 97% of French population Paid almost all taxes	
Estates General	The Parliament (Congress) of France Made up of three estates (first, second, and third) Each estate got one vote when making decisions	
Marie Antoinette	Austrian Princess Queen of France during the 1770s and 1780s Spent lots of money Known as "Madame Deficit"	
King Louis XVI	King of France during the 1770s and 1780s Weak and unpopular leader Wasn't interested in governing Inherited a huge debt from his father, Louis XV	
Old Regime	The social system in place in France during the 1770s and 1780s in which the first and second estate had all the power and the third estate was kept in poverty through an unfair tax system → the status quo French society had been organized according to this system for hundreds of years
